About

ABOUT USAS



Universiti Sultan Azlan Shah (USAS) is located at Bukit Chandan, in the Royal Town of Perak. The institution was the brainchild of the late Sultan of Perak, Almarhum Sultan Azlan Muhibbuddin Shah Al-Maghfur-lah in 1986. It was later realized in 1999 at a temporary campus complex located in Ipoh under the name Kolej Islam Darul Ridzuan (KISDAR).

It was inaugurated by His Royal Highness Almarhum Sultan Azlan Muhibbuddin Shah Al-Maghfur-lah on October 16, 1999. The institution was established under the Perak State Government Enactment Bil. 3 Year 2000. The Enactment was tabled and passed by the Dewan Undangan Negeri which later received the royal assent on March 6, 2002.

On the February 8, 2006, the State Government approved the construction of a permanent campus for KISDAR at Bukit Chandan on a piece of land donated by the then Acting Sultan of Perak Raja Dr. Nazrin Shah. The campus which cost almost RM66 million, was completed in 2008. On July 16, 2009; His Royal Highness Almarhum Sultan Azlan Muhibbuddin Shah Al-Maghfur-lah officiated the opening of the KISDAR campus at Bukit Chandan, which was later known as Kolej Universiti Islam Sultan Azlan Shah (KUISAS) after it was elevated to college university status in 2013.

KUISAS was later awarded the full-fledged university status on June 14, 2016; establishing itself as Universiti Sultan Azlan Shah (USAS).

USAS currently offers 50 programmes which cater for both local and international students alike. The programmes at the level of Foundation, Diploma, Bachelor's Degree, Masters, and PhD are offered by three faculties, namely the Faculty of Management and Information Technology, the Faculty of Islamic Studies and Social Sciences, and the Centre for Languages and Foundation Studies. All the programmes at USAS are accredited by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA) and listed under Public Services Department of Malaysia.

ABOUT WCIT



Since its inception in 2012, the World Conference on Islamic Thought and Civilization (WCIT) series, organized by Universiti Sultan Azlan Shah (USAS), has served as a distinguished international platform for intellectual engagement, policy dialogue, and scholarly collaboration on issues affecting the Muslim World and global civilization. Recognized as one of the State of Perak's official events, WCIT brings together world leaders, policymakers, academics, intellectuals, professionals, and members of civil society to exchange ideas in a dynamic environment that encourages constructive discourse and practical solutions to contemporary challenges. Beyond being an academic conference, WCIT seeks to bridge scholarship with action by promoting meaningful engagement between the Muslim World and the wider international community. The conference advocates inclusive dialogue, mutual understanding, and collaborative partnerships that contribute to sustainable peace, social development, good governance, and shared human progress.

Starting in 2016, WCIT introduced a series of interconnected themes that collectively examine the evolving role of the Muslim World in shaping the future of global civilization. **The Future World (2016)** conference explored possible futures in which Muslim societies either lead global development or actively contribute to a collectively envisioned future. **Global Peace (2017)** shifted attention to the importance of peaceful coexistence, intercultural dialogue, and international cooperation in an increasingly interconnected world. **Securing the Future (2018)** examined strategies for building resilient societies capable of addressing political, economic, technological, and environmental challenges. Following the global disruptions brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic, **Sharing Our Humanity (2022)** highlighted compassion, solidarity, and shared responsibility as foundations for rebuilding societies. This was followed by **Together We Stand: Muslims and Global Humanity (2024)**, which reaffirmed the indispensable role of Muslim nations as active partners in fostering global peace, justice, and sustainable development.

Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Energy Transition and Water Transformation of Malaysia

YAB Datuk Amar Haji Fadillah Haji Yusof is a Malaysian politician and lawyer who has served as the Deputy Prime Minister of Malaysia since 2022, making history as the first Deputy Prime Minister from Sarawak. Since 2023, he has also served as the Minister of Energy Transition and Water Transformation, while continuing his role as the Member of Parliament (MP) for Petra Jaya, a position he has held since March 2004. Prior to his current appointments, Dato' Sri Fadillah served as the Minister of Plantation and Commodities from December 2022 to December 2023. Between December 2019 and March 2020, he chaired the Science, Innovation and Environment Select Committee, becoming one of only two opposition MPs to lead a parliamentary select committee at the time. A member of Parti Pesaka Bumiputera Bersatu (PBB), a component party of the Gabungan Parti Sarawak (GPS) coalition, he serves as GPS Parliamentary Whip and has been Senior Vice President of PBB since 2017. He also served as PBB Youth Chief from 2007 to 2017.



H.E. PROF. KIETH RETHY CHHEM

Distinguished Professor of AI and Humanities, CamTech University & Senior Minister of Cambodia

Professor Kieth Rethy Chhem is a distinguished medical doctor, scientist, educator, historian, and former senior United Nations diplomat with an internationally acclaimed career spanning medicine, science, higher education, public policy, and diplomacy. He currently serves as Senior Minister of Cambodia and is an Advisory Board Member of the Institute of ASEAN Studies, University of Oxford. In 2025, he was awarded the prestigious Dr. Nagai Memorial Peace Award. Professor Chhem holds an MD, a PhD in Education, and a PhD in History. He has authored more than 200 scientific publications, co-authored 25 textbooks, and delivered keynote addresses in over 70 countries. His academic appointments include professorships at leading institutions in Canada (McGill University), Singapore (National University of Singapore), Austria (Medical University of Vienna), and Japan, specialising in radiology and nuclear medicine. From 2008 to 2014, he served as Director of the Division of Human Health at the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA). He later led the Cambodian Development Resource Institute (CDRI) and currently holds several advisory and governance roles in higher education, science, technology, and international relations. His multidisciplinary expertise spans digital and nuclear technology, geopolitics, foreign policy, medical ethics, and the history of Angkor Buddhism, making him a respected global thought leader in science, diplomacy, and sustainable development.

PROF. JOSEPH A. MASSAD

Professor of Modern Arab Politics and Intellectual History, Columbia University, USA

Joseph A. Massad is Professor of Modern Arab Politics and Intellectual History at Columbia University. He is the author of several books, dozens of scholarly articles, and hundreds of op-eds. His books include *Colonial Effects: The Making of National Identity in Jordan* (2001), *Desiring Arabs* (2007), and *Islam in Liberalism* (2014). His forthcoming book is tentatively titled *From the America to Palestine: The Age of Independence and the Global History of Settler-Colonialism* if forthcoming. He is a recipient of a number of research and teaching awards, including the Lionel Trilling Book Award for his book *Desiring Arabs*, The University of Pennsylvania's Scott Nearing Award for *Courageous Scholarship*, and The Columbia University Faculty Mentoring Award. His works have been translated to more than a dozen languages including Arabic, Turkish, Chinese, Persian, French, Italian, Spanish, Dutch, Swedish, Japanese, German, and Indonesian. Professor Massad is also a regular columnist in English and Arabic at the London-based publications Middle East Eye and Arabi21.



DR. H. A. HELLYER, FRSA

Senior Associate Fellow, Royal United Services Institute for Defence and Security Studies, UK

Dr. H. A. Hellyer is an internationally recognised expert in security, international affairs, and public policy with more than 20 years of experience spanning government, academia, and leading global think tanks. He currently serves as Senior Associate Fellow at the Royal United Services Institute (RUSI) and Senior Fellow at the Centre for American Progress, having previously held senior research positions at the Brookings Institution and the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace. Dr. Hellyer formerly served as Deputy Convenor of the UK Government's Taskforce on Radicalisation and held appointments within the UK Foreign Office. His academic affiliations include Harvard University, the University of Cambridge, and the American University in Cairo. He has authored ten books, published hundreds of articles, and led multinational research projects across Europe, the Middle East, and Southeast Asia. His expertise is frequently sought by governments and international organisations, while his insights regularly appear in major media outlets including CNN, the BBC, *The Washington Post*, *The New York Times*, and *The Guardian*. He is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts (FRSA) and the Royal Historical Society (FRHistS).

DATO' DR. AFIFI AL-AKITI, FRSA (CHAIR)

Kuwait Fellow, Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies, UK

Dato' Dr Afifi al-Akiti, FRSA, is the Kuwait Fellow at the Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies and lectures at the Faculty of Theology — Oxford University's oldest faculty. He is the first ever Malaysian to be appointed to such a position in this world-famous university. His areas of expertise are Islamic theology, law, finance and science. Dato' Afifi is internationally famous for his 2005 fatwa, *Defending the Transgressed by Censuring the Reckless Against the Killing of Civilians*, written in response to the 7 July London bombings, which was praised by scholars worldwide and gained a massive readership. In addition to his critically acclaimed written works, he has worked on several BBC documentaries, including the award winning 3-episode *Science and Islam* in 2009. In 2023, Dato' Afifi was elected as a Fellow of the Royal Academy of Jordan by HM The King of Jordan. In 2024, Dato' Afifi was appointed by the Conference of Rulers in Malaysia to be a member of the National Islamic Council (MKI) chaired by HRH The Sultan of Perak, Sultan Nazrin Muizzuddin Shah. One of Malaysia's leading scientists in membrane technology and advanced materials research, he is the Founder and First Director of the Advanced Membrane Technology Research Centre (AMTEC), Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM), a Higher Institution Centre of Excellence (HICoE) recognised internationally for pioneering research in membrane science and engineering. He also served as the 7th Vice-Chancellor of UTM from 2021 to 2024. Professor Ahmad Fauzi obtained his Bachelor of Engineering (Petroleum Engineering) and Master of Science (Chemical Engineering) from UTM before earning his PhD in Chemical and Process Engineering from the University of Strathclyde. His research focuses on membrane technology for water desalination, wastewater treatment, gas separation, renewable energy, fuel cells, and environmental sustainability.
